## "Don't Play With Women's Rights!"

Women's reproductive rights are under threat with the Conservative government. 74% of Conservative MP's have anti-abortion records, 67% said they opposed the awarding of the Order of Canada to Dr. Henry Morgentaler, and 93% voted for Bill C-484 (the "Unborn Victims of Crime Act"), which would have endangered abortion rights.
